Val has lived in Pembrokeshire for over 40 years; her three children were born and educated here.

After moving to Narberth in 1975 she became involved in fund raising for the Bloomfield Community Centre, and later became an organiser for the Narberth Children's Festival, a festival of arts, crafts and live performances taking place over three days with top performers from all over the country. This festival, which helped to put Narberth on the map, ran for several years.

Val has also worked as a professional riding instructor most of her life, training young riders to National and International level, helping with National teams and organising the Narberth Children's Pony Show.

As a member of Narberth Town Council for ten years she had responsibility for the Queens Hall and campaigned for a local Skate Park eventually contributing to the establishment of the Haverfordwest Skate Park.

She now works as a registered Foster Carer, which has given her great insight into local needs and contributed to her knowledge of young people and their aspirations

In 2014 she became a member of the Wales Green Party, a decision which was prompted by anxiety over the social injustice of recent Westminster governments and their lack of action in the face of the threat of climate change and destruction of our environment.
